The writer of the document is not mentioned.

After listing the year, day and month, day and , the writer adds the name, and "born into this world",(I will call it "b.i.t.w.") which reads as f.e. "In the year 1916, on the 5<sup>th</sup> of June, my son Sebastian was born into this world." B.i.t.w. is a phrase used in the old days to announce births. The language revealed much more than nowadays how important religious beliefs were.
